



Discerning guests looking for an intimate charter experience with a difference need look no further than AKALAM.

At 32m length, finished in graphite black with matching carbon-fibre rig and cream painted superstructure, AKALAM is a welcoming, 'family-friendly' yacht of traditional appearance that was launched in 2011.

The result of a fully bespoke design with great sailing performance, this is tasteful and beautifully appointed yacht where groups of six, or occasionally eight guests, can be accommodated in a combination of master suite plus two highly comfortable twin-berth cabins.

When eight guests are present, extra bunk-bed style accommodation can be created in the forward part of the yacht. Each guest room has en-suite facilities, while the very spacious master suite has two individual 'his and her' washrooms, each fitted-out to an exceptionally high standard using finest Italian marble for the basins.

5 star service and the very highest culinary standards will ensure expectations are exceeded as AKALAM's experienced captain and crew will do everything they can to ensure your cruising itinerary and onboard experience is unforgettable. AKALAM's audio and tele-visual entertainment systems onboard are superb and there are ipod docks in each room. The yacht is fully wi-fi enabled, so that busy executives can keep in touch with their office even at sea.

AKALAM's design and layout represents the most intelligent, up to date thinking and innovation possible and unlike other traditionally styled yachts from the past, no dark or gloomy spaces exist onboard AKALAM, and this aspect is one of her more defining characteristics.

Part of the initial design brief was for a positive 'interaction' between outside and inside. Consequently, the existence of large, panoramic glass windows, set within the hull and pilothouse area, permit magnificent



views from almost anywhere inside the yacht. Natural light engulfs large parts of the interior including the accommodation areas and enhances the overall sensory experience onboard, making the whole interior a very pleasant and comfortable place to be.

Outside, and depending upon individual inclination, guests can enjoy the sailing action while underway, or simply choose to relax amidst 60 square metres of aft-deck space. Plenty of comfortable low-level seating, additional relaxation areas and a glass dining table remain largely unencumbered by the movement of crew, while during day the space is protected from the sun via a large, fixed bimini. In the evening, likewise, a discrete under-table heating system ensures guests can while away their time, enjoying long, lazy dining experiences in comfort well into the night.

AKALAM's interior décor is a subtle blend of style, form and function, using light sycamore with contrasting dark

grey tinted zebrano and touches of olive and panga woods, interspersed with leather, to give a sophisticated 'apartment-style' feeling. A large table dominates the lower saloon area, where more formal dining experiences can take place.

AKALAM has a fully stocked aft garage, with a Seabob, bicycles and full diving gear. A Castoldi 14 Diesel Tender is located on the foredeck.
